### **AIANH / New Hampshire Architecture Foundation Awards Scholarships**

**Keene, NH** – the New Hampshire Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (AIANH) and the New Hampshire Architecture Foundation (NHAF) have announced the recipients of their jointly sponsored scholarship programs for New Hampshire residents. \$1,000 grants were given to Michael Kulikowski of Merrimack, NH, who attends Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University; and Julie Rahilly, entering the Wentworth Institute of Technology this fall. A \$500 award went to Michelle Wood, also at Virginia Tech. Both Ms. Rahilly and Ms. Wood are from Nashua.

The AIANH-NHAF Scholarship program is new this year. It has two grant categories, one for students who are currently enrolled or accepted to an accredited undergraduate or graduate professional architecture degree program; the other for students currently enrolled in or accepted to an accredited undergraduate program with a major in architecture or related field, such as landscape architecture, architectural history, architectural preservation, and planning.
